

## OBITUARY FOR TERENCE REID.

Terence Reid: (Mullins)

Dates at St. Andrews: 1955 – 1958

Terence Reid died suddenly on the 13<sup>th</sup> July 2015 due to cancer related problems.

After leaving school Terence did a law degree at Wits University. In 1964 he left South Africa for Canada where he attended Toronto University and achieved an MBA degree. He was also a graduate of the Director Education Programme of the institute of Corporate Directors.

After graduating 1966 Terence was hired by Wood Gundy Investment Bank in Toronto and moved to their Montreal branch soon after. In 1990, after a most successful and rewarding time in Montreal, Terence moved back to the Wood Gundy head office in Toronto. He retired as Vice-Chairman of CIBC Wood Gundy in 1997 after a career there spanning 31 years during which he provided investment banking services to many of Canada's leading corporations and helped to develop an internet start-up business. Terence served on a number of companies' boards and investment industry committees. He was the Chairman of the Montreal Stock Exchange.

Described by a number of friends as a gentleman and a scholar, Terence's curiosity, cool sense of humour and sharp wit inspired and delighted everyone around him. He is remembered as an encouraging, confidant colleague, golf companion and a devoted husband and father.

Terence is survived by his wife, Julie, daughter Alison and sons Michael and Christopher.
